



Rural roads built under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) since 2000 appear to have had no effect on increasing the vote share of incumbent parties in both assembly and Lok Sabha constituencies across India, finds a study by Oxford University researcher Tanushree Goyal.
